This program is intended for low-income seniors who receive single-family home trash service in the City of West Covina. To participate in the Athens Low-Income Senior Discount Program, residents must be 62 or older, have a valid drivers license or identification showing proof of age, live in a single-family home residence in West Covina, meet low-income requirements set by the State of California, and have an Athens billing account under the applicant's name.



Remember Fire Safety Tips This Holiday Season

Each year, fires occurring during the holiday season injure more than 2,500 people and cause more than \$390 million in damage.

The West Covina Fire Department offers the following holiday fire safety tips to keep you and your family safe through the holiday season.

Preventing Christmas Tree Fires

- Select a fresh tree. Needles on fresh trees should be green and hard to pull from the branches, and the needles should not break if the tree has been freshly cut. If many needles fall off, the tree has probably dried out and is a fire hazard.

- Keep your tree watered. Keep the tree stand filled with water at all times. Place the tree away from heat sources, such as fireplaces and heaters. Do not put your live tree up too early or leave it up for longer than two weeks.

- Properly dispose of your tree. West Covina residents may safely dispose of their Christmas trees from Dec. 26 to Jan. 9. Place your undecorated tree next to your trash bin on your regular trash collection day. Do not place your tree inside the trash bin.



Holiday Lights

- Maintain your holiday lights. Inspect lights each season for bare spots, gaps in insulation, broken sockets, and frayed wires before using them.

- Only use lighting listed by an approved testing laboratory, such as those that read "UL listed."

- Use only light sets marked as "indoors" or "indoor/outdoor" for use inside your home.

- Do not overload electrical outlets. Use lighting according to manufacturer's recommendations.

- Keep all your lights away from combustible materials, such as fabrics or paper decorations.

- Turn off all lights, appliances and other electrical equipment when the room is unattended and before leaving for the day and going to bed at night.

Candle Care

- Avoid using lit candles in the home. If you do use them, make sure they are in stable holders, and place them in an area where they cannot be easily knocked down.

- Never leave a burning candle unattended.

- Never put lit candles on a Christmas tree.

Other Safety Tips

- Only use non-flammable decorations. If you are using an artificial tree, make sure it is flame-retardant.

- Injuries due to falls are a major holiday



hazard. If you need to hang something higher than you can safely reach, use approved ladders and not a chair, desk or box. Plan your decorating to minimize trip hazards or snagging clothing.

- Make sure seasonal decorations do not block, hide or obscure safety equipment such as fire alarm strobe lights or sirens, safety signage or evacuation plans, fire extinguishers, or safety showers.

- If you are serving food during the holiday season, remember to keep your hot foods hot (>140 degrees F) and cold foods cold (<40 degrees F) while serving and storing.

Ride Smart with Go West Shuttle and Dial A Ride

The City of West Covina contracts with MV Transportation, Inc. (MVT) to provide transportation services to West Covina residents through the “Go West” fixed-route shuttle system. MVT operates the city’s Fixed Route Shuttle as well as a Dial-A-Ride service for seniors older than 55 and individuals with disabilities.

The Go West shuttle system includes the red, green and blue lines and travels throughout West Covina. Residents can hop on or off along the shuttle lines, and the fare per ride is \$1 each way. Residents who choose to ride Go West through the Dial A Ride program must make an appointment for a ride, which can be done a few different ways:

- **Same-Day Service** – Appointments are available by calling MVT on a “first-come, first-served” basis.
- **Next-Day Service** – Riders may book a total of six one-way trips for one or more persons per call, up to two weeks in advance.



- **Subscription Service/Standing Orders** – Riders should make a reservation approximately two weeks before the trip. The standing order needs to be consistent for a minimum of four weeks, and trips do not have to be at the same time each day of the week.

Riders who wish to venture outside city limits through Go West need to plan ahead, as the Dial A Ride trips are limited to up to three miles outside of West Covina for medical purposes only.

Those using Dial A Ride need to keep in mind that this transportation program is a shared-rider program, and last-

minute requests can sometimes be difficult to fulfill depending on the schedule.

For residents who cannot utilize the Go West shuttle or Dial A Ride, other public transportation options are available in West Covina, including Foothill Transit, Access Services and taxi cabs or other shared-ride services, such as Uber or Lyft.


