Stay Cool at the Pool!

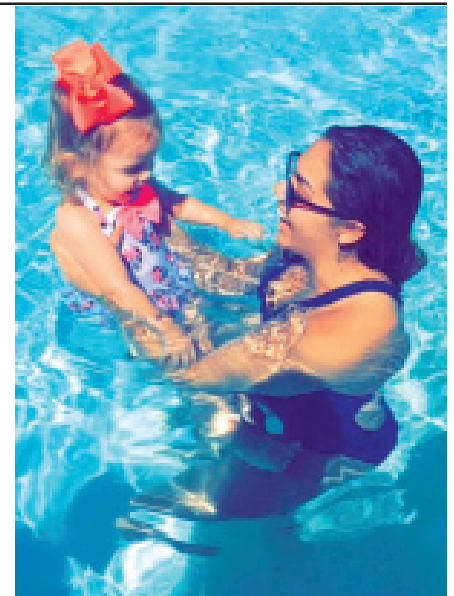
West Covina Municipal Pool Opens Soon

Be on the lookout in June for the new Discover City Newsletter and Community Recreation Guide!

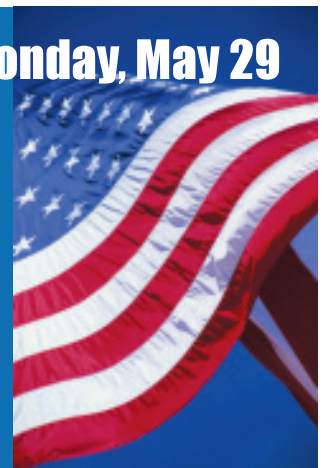
City of West Covina to Host Memorial Day Ceremony Monday, May 29

Compete Successfully

This past January, West Covina Police Youth Explorers competed in the 2017 Chandler Explorer Competition in Arizona.

In competitions with Explorers from dozens of other police departments, West Covina earned trophies in events including the Hostage Rescue Team, Decision Shoot, and 5K runs.

West Covina's Explorer program is open to youth between the ages of 14 and 21 who are interested in law enforcement.

The Explorers attend an 18-week academy focusing on law, discipline and self-control, and then meet weekly at the West Covina Police Department for continued training.

This low-cost program engages the minds and bodies of participants, provides mentoring and exposes them to the police profession as an avenue of future employment.

In addition to their regular public safety duties, WCPD officers volunteer their time to teach and facilitate the Explorer program.

CITY OF WEST COVINA GRAFFITI ABATEMENT PROGRAM

The City of West Covina works to combat graffiti using a variety of methods, including quick eradication, arrest of graffiti vandals, and community education and outreach.

By working collaboratively with the West Covina Police Department, the West Covina Public Works Department and the community, we can better control and maintain the cleanup process for graffiti in West Covina. Our best

partners in this process are you, members of the community. As with other crimes, "If you see something, say something!"

Report graffiti to the City in any of the following three ways:

- 1) Via the City's website at www.westcovina.org/servicerequest
- 2) Via the City's mobile app
- 3) By calling the Graffiti Hotline at (626) 939-8800.

The website and the mobile app are the preferred methods for

faster cleanup response and tracking purposes.

Reporting graffiti not only helps keep our City clean, but you could potentially receive a cash reward! If you witness graffiti in progress and can provide information that leads to the arrest of the graffiti vandal, you could be eligible for a \$100 reward while still remaining anonymous.

To report graffiti in progress, call 9-1-1 immediately.

Passport Services Available at City Hall

The City Clerk's Office at West Covina City Hall offers one-stop service and assistance in filing U.S. passport applications by personnel trained in passport application procedures.



Passport photos are also available.

The City Clerk's office, 1444 W. Garvey Ave., is open for passport application acceptance on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. No appointment is necessary; walk-in service is available.

This annual program provides once a year, **unlimited pick-up** of household trash. This program is available to City of West Covina **residential customers only**. It does not include L.A. County unincorporated areas.

All items must be **placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m.** on your designated Saturday. Vegetation and tree branches must be cut and bundled to no longer than 4 ft. in length. In order to prevent trash from overflowing and spilling into the street all trash must be contained in a trash bin or closed container such as a box or bag. Please see below for a list of items that **do not qualify** for pick-up.

If you miss your Saturday, please call Athens Services at (888)336-6100 to arrange for a regular bulky-item pick-up (**24 hr. advance notice required**).

ITEMS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PICK-UP:

- Any Hazardous materials (see reverse)
- Rocks, dirt, sand, gravel, sod, asphalt, concrete, etc.
- Unbound vegetation & branches
- Electronic Waste, TV's, monitors, batteries
- Automobile parts, tires, oil
- Any items placed after the area has been serviced.

Check Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors

The time has come and gone to set your clocks for Daylight Saving Time. We changed our clocks on March 12 at 2 a.m., but have you checked the smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in your home?

Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors save lives, and when installed and maintained, they play a vital role in reducing fire deaths and injuries. The West Covina Fire Department reminds everyone to test the batteries in their smoke and carbon monoxide detectors at least once a month and to replace the batteries at each time change.

Make sure you have enough detectors by installing them throughout your home. Smoke detectors should be installed in

each bedroom and outside each separate sleeping area. Large homes may need more smoke detectors, with a minimum of one smoke detector per floor.

It's important to remember that your home's smoke detectors should be replaced every 10 years. To determine the age of your smoke detector, look at the back to find the manufacture date. Replace any smoke detector that does not respond properly when being tested. If you have a combination smoke/carbon monoxide detector, refer to the user manual for replacement recommendations.

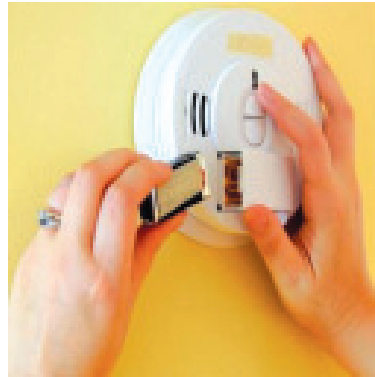
In addition to having properly installed and maintained detectors, every family should have an escape plan for when a smoke alarm sounds off in the home. Everyone in the household should

know how to get out of every room in the home in less than two minutes.

Once you have a plan, make sure to practice with your family to make sure that everyone knows

what to do in the event of an emergency.

HOUSING PRESERVATION LOAN PROGRAM

Do you have pending home improvements that are in dire need? Do you have home improvement projects that you have been putting off? Do you have a leaky roof or are you in need of new windows? Need to replace a block wall or is your home in need of a fresh coat of paint? West Covina homeowners can apply for a Housing Preservation Loan from the West Covina Community and Economic Development Division for up to \$10,000 to make the home improvements that your home is in need of. The City of West Covina Housing Preservation Program (HPP) makes available to eligible West Covina homeowners (please see income guidelines below) a 5% interest loan of up to \$10,000 for exterior improvements. Loans repaid within the first ten (10) years accrue no interest. The loan aims to assure that West Covina's homes are preserved, well maintained and of quality living conditions.

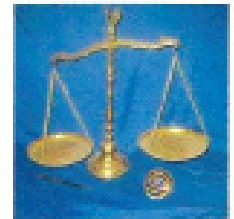

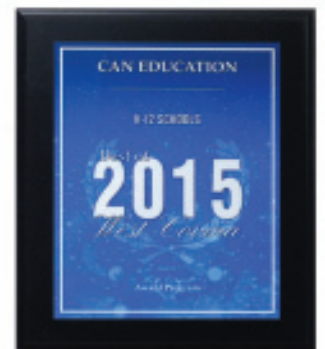
