## West Covina Selected as a 'Host Town' for 2015 Special Olympics World Games

**O**n Monday, May 5, the City of West Covina was selected by the Special Olympics to be a "host town" for the 2015 Special Olympics World Games to be held in Los Angeles from July 25 to Aug. 2.

With more than 7,000 Special Olympians from 177 countries coming to Los Angeles, cities throughout Southern California will serve as host towns from July 21 to 24, 2015, to allow the athletes to become acclimated to the greater Los Angeles area.

As a host town, West Covina will provide visiting Special Olympics athletes with the opportunity to learn about and experience American culture, as well as share their own culture with the community. West



Covina residents, civic groups and businesses plan to roll out the red carpet for the visiting athletes, with community rallies, a summer concert in the park, old-fashioned American cuisine, and diverse activities to showcase West Covina as part of the melting pot of Southern California.

"The Host Town program is an exciting way for Southern California locals to open our doors and show the athletes and coaches from around the world our hospitality and our culture," said Patrick McClenahan, president and CEO of LA2015, the Games' organizing committee. "This is an important part of the World Games experience and a truly meaningful way for different communities to be part of the

Games and create lasting memories for our visiting athletes."

## SCE Releases Smartphone App for Power Outage Information

A smartphone app from Southern California Edison (SCE) makes reporting or checking on the status of a power outage quick and simple.

The "SCE Outages" application includes an interactive map that allows customers to quickly find outage information, including the location and size of outages and estimated power restoration times, all in an easy-to-use mobile interface.

The SCE outages app was developed in response to customers' requests for improved communication regarding service outages during past storms. This free mobile application for iPhone and Android devices enables users to conveniently report power outages and street light outages, or check on the status of a maintenance or repair outage. As an important safety reminder, if you see a downed power line, do not approach or touch it, but instead call 911.

## WEST COVINA URGES RESIDENTS TO

**A**s California's main water sources have been severely impacted by record dry conditions, the drought continues to worsen.

Cutting water use inside and outside your home not only saves you money, it can also help to benefit the greater community. If we all make changes in our water-use habits, we could save billions of gallons of water.

Here is a list of general water-saving tips:

1. Adjust sprinklers and irrigation systems to avoid overspray, runoff and waste.
2. Avoid watering in the hot part of the day or during morning and evening peak hours, and avoid watering on



windy days.

3. Install or replace landscaping with drought-tolerant trees and plants and water-saving irrigation systems; mulch around plants to hold water in soil.
4. Shut off decorative fountains unless a water recycling system is used.
5. Do not hose down driveways, sidewalks or other paved surfaces.
6. Install pool and spa covers to minimize water loss due to

evaporation.

7. Do not allow water to run while washing the car; use a hose with an automatic cutoff valve.
8. Turn off water while brushing teeth and scrubbing dishes.
9. Retrofit indoor plumbing fixtures such as showerheads and toilets with low-flow devices.
10. Check faucets, toilets and pipes both indoor and outdoor for leaks, and repair them immediately.
11. Use energy-efficient appliances such as dishwashers and washing machines, and only run full loads.
12. Take shorter showers; turn water on to get wet, then off to lather up, and back on to rinse off.





## State Organization Honors West Covina Dispatcher

The California Public-Safety Radio Association recently recognized West Covina Public Safety Senior Operator Sylvia Dorsey as runner-up “Telecommunicator of the Year” at the association’s annual awards banquet.

Dorsey was honored for her excellence in handling an emergency service call in West Covina involving a childbirth. On June 22, 2011, Dorsey answered a 911 call and found that a woman was in full labor. The telephone was passed to several members of the household during this very stressful event. Dorsey gleaned information from each of them and calmly provided instructions to safely deliver the baby as paramedics and police hastened to the site.

The child was born safely at the site, and Dorsey provided post-delivery instructions until paramedics arrived.

Dorsey’s expertise, composure and compassion were critical to the safety of the newborn child and other family members. The City of West Covina joins the California Public-Safety Radio Association in recognizing Dorsey for her outstanding work.





# Be Prepared in the Event of an **EARTHQUAKE**

Multiple casualties and hundreds of millions of dollars in destruction have been linked to recent large-magnitude earthquakes on the Pacific Coast. Due to the possibility that emergency services could be delayed from the effects of a significant natural disaster in our area, the West Covina Fire Department would like to inform you on how to best prepare, survive and recover from an earthquake.

**Prepare** an earthquake kit by gathering the following items:

- Food (non-perishable type with a can opener)
- Drinking water (one gallon per person per day, with a three-day minimum)
- Radio (battery-operated and portable)
- Fire extinguisher (minimum type 2A 10BC)
- First-aid kit
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Medications, hygiene products and toiletries
- Multipurpose tool
- Cell phone (including charger)

**Survive** during an earthquake by using the **“Drop, Cover, and Hold On,”** technique:

- Drop to the floor as soon as you feel the earthquake.
- Cover your head and neck by taking shelter underneath a sturdy object, such as a table or desk.
- Hold onto the sturdy object until the shaking stops.

**Recover** once the shaking has stopped.

- Expect aftershocks.
- Assess for injuries and damages.
- Assist others if possible.
