

# Visit Hurst Ranch for History and More

The Hurst Ranch hosts a variety of events and programs for the public to enjoy. The Hurst Ranch is located at 1227 S. Orange Ave. in West Covina.

## **Harvest Festival**

The Hurst Ranch is open to the public for the annual Harvest Festival, which is held on the third Saturday in October.

## **School Field Trips**

K-third and fourth-grade school field trips let students relive a day on the Hurst Ranch from the 1920s. This is an award-winning, curriculum-based, hands-on field trip with experienced docents.

Students will experience churning butter, squeezing juice, sacking walnuts, visiting a general store, farm chores, picking a seasonal crop, getting a glimpse of cowboy life when they hunker down in the bunk house, and do some roping and wrangling.

Fourth-graders will also hear miners' tales and pan for gold, walk in the footsteps of Gabrielino Indians, design their own brand and logo, and experience music from the period.

## **Garden Gourmets Program**

Kaiser Permanente, the West Covina Unified School District and the Hurst Ranch have partnered to develop a first-of-its-kind nutrition/gardening program in West Covina. This program is designed and led by science and nutrition professionals.

The Garden Gourmets program aims to reduce obesity in youth by teaching lifelong food preparation skills, healthy

eating habits that will continue for a lifetime, and how to grow food and prepare recipes that can easily be made at home.

## **Community Center Rental**

The Hurst Ranch has a 400-guest event center for community and private events, such as weddings, fund raisers, and corporate parties, offering settings for both formal and informal dining. See the Web site for details and photos.



## **Brief History of the Hurst Ranch**

The Hurst family included Josiah Newell; his wife, Anna Belle; and their three children, Allie, Harriet Maude and Charles Josiah. The family moved from Dover, Ohio to Whittier, Calif. in 1898. In 1906, the family purchased 50 acres on the corner of Orange and Merced in West Covina.

Soon, a barn, an engine house, a pump house and a home were built. This became the Hurst Ranch headquarters, where Charles Josiah and his wife, Maude, lived and raised their family. Anna Belle was born in 1913, and Charles Josiah Jr. (Joe) was born in 1914.

With hard work, strong family ties and community roots, the children grew and flourished on the ranch. Both Anna Belle and Joe attended Sunset Grammar School and Covina High School. Annabelle then graduated from Pomona College and Joe from USC.

After college and marriage, farming was still a way of life for the Hurst family. Joe and his wife, Ruth, and Anna Belle and her husband, Sanford, carried on and expanded the operation from the mid 1930s to the late 1950s.

The primary crops were walnuts from 1919 to 1929 for the Diamond label, and from 1930 to 1950 oranges were grown for Sunkist. Over the years, truck crops were added, including potatoes, beans, cucumbers, onions, cabbages, cauliflower and carrots. The Hurst Ranch grew to about 70 acres planted in oranges and 70 acres planted in seasonally rotated crops.

During the 1950s, West Covina began to grow people and houses instead of oranges. For the Hurst family, this meant moving the farming operation to the San Joaquin Valley and, with a bit of sadness, developing the West Covina property.

Those early 1906 roots in West Covina were planted deep within the family and after over 100 years still grow strong today. With the formation of this museum on the remaining 3 acres of the Hurst Ranch (and the only existing remnants of a working ranch in the San Gabriel Valley), the Hurst family hopes to preserve a small yet special part of rural history for others to enjoy. In keeping with the Hurst Ranch mission statement, as we continue to develop, we continue to "Preserve the Past... Harvest the Present... Plant Seed for the Future."

WCPD offers a variety of assignments, including patrol, traffic enforcement, detectives, narcotics enforcement, K9's, SWAT, crisis negotiations, robotics, and forensics.

Currently, the Patrol Division operates on a 3/12.5 schedule, while the Investigative Division, Traffic Bureau and Administrative Division operate on a 4/10 schedule.

Retirement benefit for laterals (from agencies with a PERS reciprocal agreement) is on the 3% at 55 formula, while entry-level officers are on the 2.7% at 57 formula.


