## GET SET FOR WEST COVINA PUMPKIN 5K

On Saturday, Oct. 24, the Third Annual West Covina Pumpkin 5K Run/Walk and a 1K Children's Fun Run will be held at the West Covina Senior Center at 2501 E. Cortez St.

The West Covina Christian Church is sponsoring this run, and proceeds go to senior programs at the West Covina Senior Center. More than \$4,000 was raised each of the last two years through community participation and support.



The 5K course is USATF-certified and runs through the South Hills community of West Covina.



## WCPD OFFERS 'VACATION HOUSE CHECK' SERVICE

**D**id you know that the West Covina Police Department offers a service to check on your home while you are away on vacation? The "Vacation House Check" service has been offered to West Covina residents for more than 25 years.

You provide information including your home address, the dates you will be gone, which cars should be in the driveway and your contact information, and WCPD will have your home checked daily. For more information or to request this service, call (626) 939-8557.

Here are some travel tips to help you prepare for that family vacation:

- Plan ahead. The earlier you book your air, ship or train travel, the cheaper the fares may be.
- Know the rules for any flights planned. Research the TSA Web site for the rules before you pack. Visit [www.tsa.gov](http://www.tsa.gov).
- Prepare your travel documents early. Passports can take up to six weeks to get in the off season, and during the summer season they can take even longer.
- Consider notifying a trusted neighbor to keep watch over your home.
- Contact the U.S. Postal Service and the newspaper service to hold any deliveries until your return.
- Consider night light timers and sensors to be in operation during your time away.
- Avoid posting on social media that you are away from your home and traveling. This may attract unwanted attention to your vacant home.



# Conserve Water with These Useful Tips

**A**s California's main water sources have been severely impacted by record dry conditions, the drought continues to worsen.

Cutting water use inside and outside your home not only saves you money, it can also help to benefit the greater community. If we all make changes in our water-use habits, we could save billions of gallons of water.

Here are some water-saving tips:

1. Adjust sprinklers and irrigation systems to avoid overspray and runoff.

2. Avoid watering in the hot part of the day or during morning and evening peak hours, and avoid watering on windy days.

3. Install or replace landscaping with drought-tolerant trees and plants and water-saving irrigation systems. Mulch around plants to hold water in soil.

4. Shut off decorative fountains unless a water recycling system is used.

5. Do not hose down driveways, sidewalks or other paved surfaces.

6. Install pool and spa covers to minimize water loss by evaporation.

7. Do not allow water to run while

washing the car; use a hose with an automatic cutoff valve.

8. Turn off water while brushing teeth and scrubbing dishes.

9. Retrofit indoor plumbing fixtures, such as showerheads and toilets, with low-flow devices.

10. Check faucets, toilets and pipes for leaks, and repair immediately.

11. Use energy-efficient appliances, and only run full washing machine loads.

12. Take shorter showers. Turn water on to get wet, then off to lather up, and back on to rinse off.
