BACKGROUND

The City annually receives federal CDBG funds. To receive these funds, the City is required to prepare an annual CDBG Action Plan that describes how the funds will be used to meet its long-term community development needs.

FY 2017-2018 CDBG ACTION PLAN

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018, the City will receive \$732,715 from HUD. The City proposes the utilization of granted CDBG funds along with estimated program income to be received, as well as the reprogramming of unexpended prior year resources to implement the projects listed below:
