A SOFTWARE UPGRADE AGREEMENT)

BACKGROUND:

ComNet's primary infrastructure consists of two simulcast transmitter sites; one is on Johnstone Peak and the second is located at the BKK landfill. The transmitter sites and dispatch consoles are interconnected via Internet Protocol based technology, and are controlled by complex proprietary software packages, which are in need of upgrade.

DISCUSSION:

The ICI-System, which ComNet is interconnected, is largely controlled and receives its robust feature sets from the proprietary software produced Motorola Solutions. The design of the system requires that all system users be on the same version of the software, which is currently at operating system version 7.14. As version 7.14 is nearing its end of life, Motorola proposed a lengthy concept of a Software Upgrade Agreement (SUA) to the ICI-System governance board. The SUA concept would have provided annual software updates as part of the agreement as well as hardware replacements for equipment that became obsolete due to upgraded software. The SUA as proposed by Motorola originally consisted of a 10-year agreement that had a large initial cost, followed by annual maintenance payments between \$79,279 and \$80,346. The total costs for ComNet over the life of the SUA was \$1,090,921. These costs were deemed untenable by ComNet and were not approved by the ICI-Systems Board.

The second proposal from Motorola eliminated the initial cost but still maintained the existing annual maintenance payments. This too was untenable for ComNet and also was not approved by the ICI-Systems Board.

Ultimately, the ICI-Systems Board was able to negotiate a single upgrade from operating system version 7.14 to 7.18 that would be valid for a period of at least four years before any other action would be needed. The net cost to ComNet would be a one-time expense of \$77,744.

On June 7, 2018, the ICI-Systems Governance Board authorized the Executive Director to execute an agreement with Motorola Solutions, and to apportion costs to the member agencies. ICI-Systems will make one payment to Motorola Solutions on behalf of the consortium and will invoice the member entities no later than October 1, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The SUA would represent an overall \$77,744 impact on ComNet, which would be transferred from retained earnings. There would otherwise be no impact on our operating budget.

THE EAST SAN GABRIEL VALLEY REGIONAL COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK GOVERNANCE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the East San Gabriel Valley Regional Communications Network Governance Board (COM-NET) has adopted a budget for the operation of the East San Gabriel Valley Regional Communications Network for Fiscal Year 2018-19, commencing July 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Changes to the budget throughout the fiscal year require Board approval.

WHEREAS, the ICI-System Governance Board has accepted a proposal from Motorola Solutions to migrate the ICI-System Network in its entirety to Operating System 7.18; and

WHEREAS, ICI-Systems is issuing a single payment of \$1,305,588 to Motorola Solutions for the aggregate cost of the migration; and

WHEREAS, the cost of migration has been apportioned to the member agencies based on the specific scope of work for each member, and \$77,744 was been apportioned to the ComNet Joint Powers Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE GOVERNANCE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** Amend the adopted budget, appropriating \$77,744 from retained earnings to ICI-Systems Membership expenditures account.
- **SECTION 2.** Authorize the Chair to issue payment in the amount of \$77,744 to ICI-Systems no later than October 1, 2018.
- **SECTION 3.** Authorize the Chair to sign and the Board Secretary to certify the passage and adoption of this resolution, enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions and that this resolution shall take effect and be in force on this date.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board provide the Chair with

BACKGROUND:

ComNet's primary infrastructure consists of two simulcast transmitter sites, one proposed additional transmitter site, and six dispatch locations using MCC7500 Consoles. The transmitter sites and dispatch consoles are interconnected via Internet Protocol based technology.

DISCUSSION:

The ICI-System, which ComNet is interconnected, is largely controlled and receives its robust feature sets from the proprietary software produced Motorola Solutions. The connectivity in ComNet currently consists of a blend of T1 telco lines, PTP Ethernet, and microwave. Within the next calendar year, ICI Systems and ComNet will be migrating to technology that will cause some of this technology to be obsolete. The consortium will be deploying IP technology called Mulitprotocol Label Switching (MPLS), which means that as data moves over IP throughout the system, the routing is significantly more efficient. The reduction in network latency improves quality of service, system performance and system stability.

The integration of MPLS will cause some IP infrastructure to become obsolete. At any point where two or more data connections aggregate, an MPLS router/switch is required. Currently, ComNet owns none of this equipment. Tentatively, new routers would be required at the three transmitter sites.

ComNet does not have comprehensive purchase policies, and as such, it is recommended that the Chair be authorized to negotiate and approve the purchase of the required equipment with Motorola or one of its authorized affiliates, within the capabilities of our retained earnings and/or current operating budget.

CEQA (CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT):

FISCAL IMPACT:

The purchase of the required equipment will impact ComNet at a value yet to be determined, but for FY2018-2019 will not exceed current retained earnings or the approved operating budget.
