FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR 2019-20."

DISCUSSION:

Each year the Board adopts an annual budget and apportions annual costs per agency. For the past several years, the proposed annual budget has been \$210,000/\$35,000 per agency (6), and recently \$245,000/\$35,000 per agency with the addition of Baldwin Park.. ComNet has yet to increase member fees in at least five years.

The FY2019-20 budget encompasses unique challenges. In January of this year, the Board approved adding approximately \$70,000 in infrastructure necessary to complete our data backhaul project. This is the final component that interconnects the existing repeater sites, console dispatch centers via microwave, adds a third repeater site, and adds 4 additional channel pairs to the entire system. Much of this work was accomplished using \$1.8M in grant funds. This advanced backhaul will enable our members with MCC7500 consoles to reduce their fiber connectivity to Glendale to a single circuit, thereby saving each agency approximately \$9,000 per year in fiber lease fees. The \$70,000 expenditure is included in the *System Infrastructure Upgrades* line-item of \$80,000 which is normally budgeted at \$20,000. We expect this amount to revert back to \$20,000 in next year's budget.

The proposed budget also includes ComNet's membership fee to the ICI System, which supports the connectivity to the Master Site in Glendale, and the roaming/wide area capability with the other member cities' systems. For this fiscal year, our membership fees to ICI Systems have increased from \$50,000 to \$70,000. ICI System billing practices are based on aggregate population of the member cities, and ICI Systems had generously discounted ComNet's annual membership due to difficulties in the early years of the systems existence. We are now at the structured pricing model for our system size and expect this to be an ongoing expenditure.

For FY2019-20, ComNet will complete our plans to create IP connectivity to the Glendale Master Site, and reduce our reliance on T1 technology. The *T1 Circuit Lease* line-item has been reduced from \$33,000 to \$20,000, as this category has been underspent for the past several years The JPA will maintain the remaining T1 lines until the Motorola OS 7.18 is implemented.

We also propose modest costs for Administration, legal and travel costs.

The most significant cost to ComNet is that of our Motorola Site & Console Hardware Maintenance agreements. This cost has risen to \$104,221 from approximately \$99,252 last fiscal year. These costs generally increase 4-5% per year, thus the increase is expected.

This year, expenditures will exceed revenues by a minimum of \$21,214. This is due to the increases in ICI Systems fees of \$20,000 (on-going) and the \$70,000 increase in the *System Infrastructure Upgrades* for this FY (one-time). There is sufficient cash on hand in retained earnings to cover the variance, however the Board should consider our membership fees as we move into the upcoming years.

The ComNet system will be fully built out by the end of this year, and aside from on-going Motorola maintenance, the only expected large expenditures will be Motorola *Software Update Agreements* (SUA) that will be required from time to time. The most recent (SUA) was funded in FY2018-2019 and should not be required again for approximately 4 years.

For the Board's consideration are three options for the operating budget, any of which may be adopted by the Board.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The first version is constructed with no fee increase for FY19-20. If adopted, this would create \$245,000 in revenue, and in \$301,214 in expenditures. We would require \$56,214 from retained earnings for this fiscal year to cover operating costs.

The second version is constructed with a fee increase of \$2,500 per agency for FY19-20. If adopted, this would create \$262,000 in revenue, and in \$301,214 in expenditures. We would require \$38,714 from retained earnings for this fiscal year to cover operating costs.

The third version is constructed with a fee increase of \$5,000 for FY19-20. If adopted, this would create \$280,000 in revenue, and in \$301,214 in expenditures. We would require \$21,214 from retained earnings for this fiscal year to cover operating costs.
