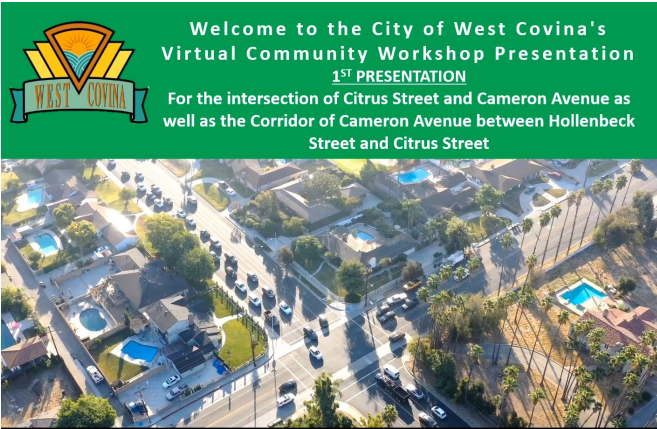

Guidelines will be released on Thursday May 7th

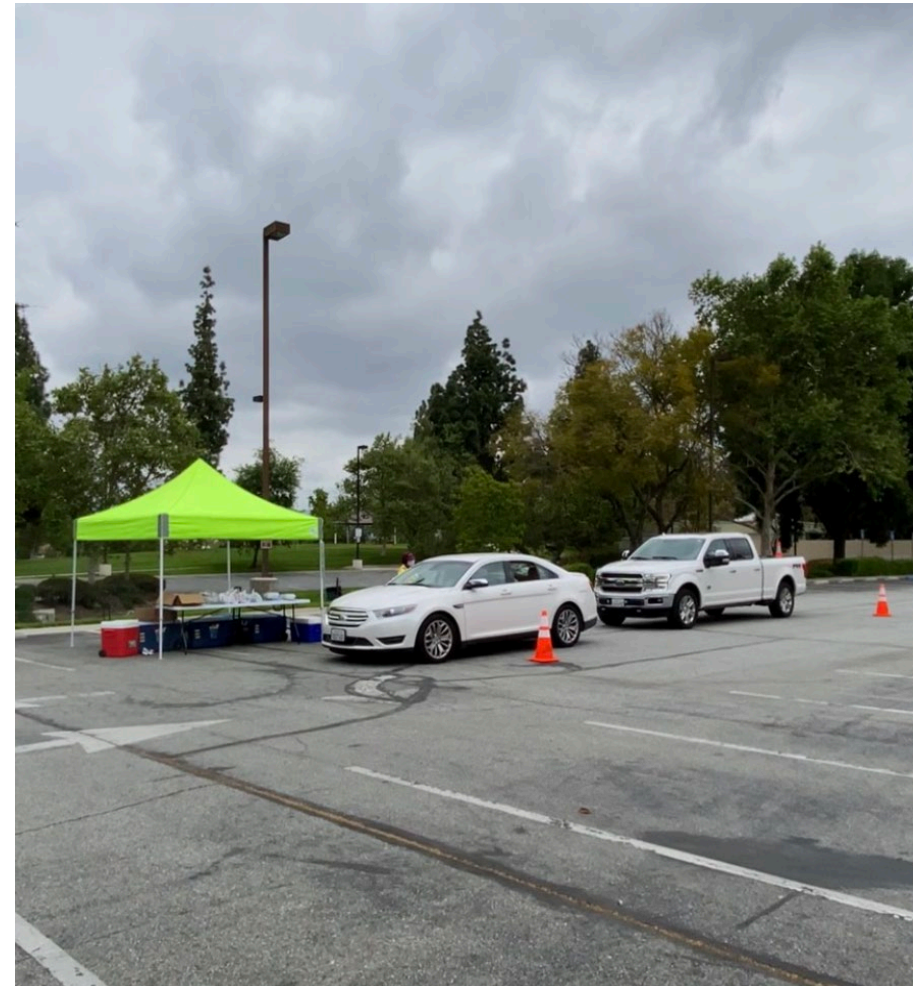

- LA Regional Food Bank Boxes
 - Non-perishable foods
 - Will be distributed with meal deliveries

- Served 11,176 Meals
- 400 LA Regional Food Bank Boxes Distributed
- Islands Donated 100 meals every Wednesday totaling 500 meals for April
