- ZOOS AND MUSEUMS
- CARDROOMS



**OPERATION PROTOCOLS** 

**UPDATED AS OF JULY 2, 2020** 



GYMS AND FITNESS FACILITIES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE PATRONS TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS AND GLOVE ENTIRE TIME THEY ARE IN THE FACILITY EXCEPT WHEN THE ARE IN THE POOL OR IN THE SHOWER

WHERE POSSIBLE, DO NOT CLEAN FLOORS BY SWEEPING OR OTHER METHODS THAT CAN DISPERSE PATHOGENS INTO THE AIR. USE A VACUUM WITH A HEPA FILTER WHEREVER POSSIBLE

#### **HOW TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS**









MAKE SURE THAT YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH ARE FULLY COVERED

THE MASK SHOULD FIT SNUGLY ON THE SIDE OF YOUR FACE

YOUR CLOTH MASK AFTER EACH USE

#### WEAR A MASK/FACE COVERINGS WHEN:

- INTERACTING WITH PEOPLE OUTSIDE OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD
- IN PUBLIC, INDOOR SETTINGS
- OUTSIDE WHEN PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE
- ANY INDOOR PUBLIC PLACE (INSIDE OF AND IN LINE TO ENTER)
- PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
  - PASSENGERS WHILE WAITING FOR & RIDING
  - DRIVING/OPERATING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (INCLUDING RIDESHARING)

- ENGAGED IN WORK
  - INTERACTING IN-PERSON WITH THE PUBLIC
  - WORKING IN SPACE VISITED BY THE PUBLIC (EVEN IF PUBLIC IS NOT PRESENT)
  - WORKING WITH FOOD
  - WORKING/WALKING THROUGH COMMON AREAS (HALLWAYS, STAIRS, ELEVATORS, PARKING FACILITIES)
  - ENCLOSED ROOM WITH OTHER PEOPLE WHEN UNABLE TO PHYSICAL DISTANCING
- OUTDOORS IN PUBLIC SPACES WHEN UNABLE TO MAINTAIN A PHYSICAL
  DISTANCE OF 6 FT FROM PERSONS NOT MEMBERS OF THE SAME HOUSEHOLD OR
  RESIDENCE
