UPDATE ON HOMELESS PREVENTION

Year	Count
2017	166
2018	262
2016	145
2020	124

- 55 Individuals contacted & enrolled in County Coordinated Entry System (CES): Full-time Housing Navigator under contract with Union Station Homeless Services providing assistance with Driver's License, Social Security Card, Veteran's benefits, housing services, etc.
- 3,400 incident responses in last 12 months by Homeless Outreach Parks Program (HOPE) Team
- 38 individuals placed into motels in surrounding communities through Project Room Key
- 21-day notice required for clean-up of encampments
- Homeless is not a crime, but public drinking, urination and harassment is

- Provides assistance on an “as needed” basis

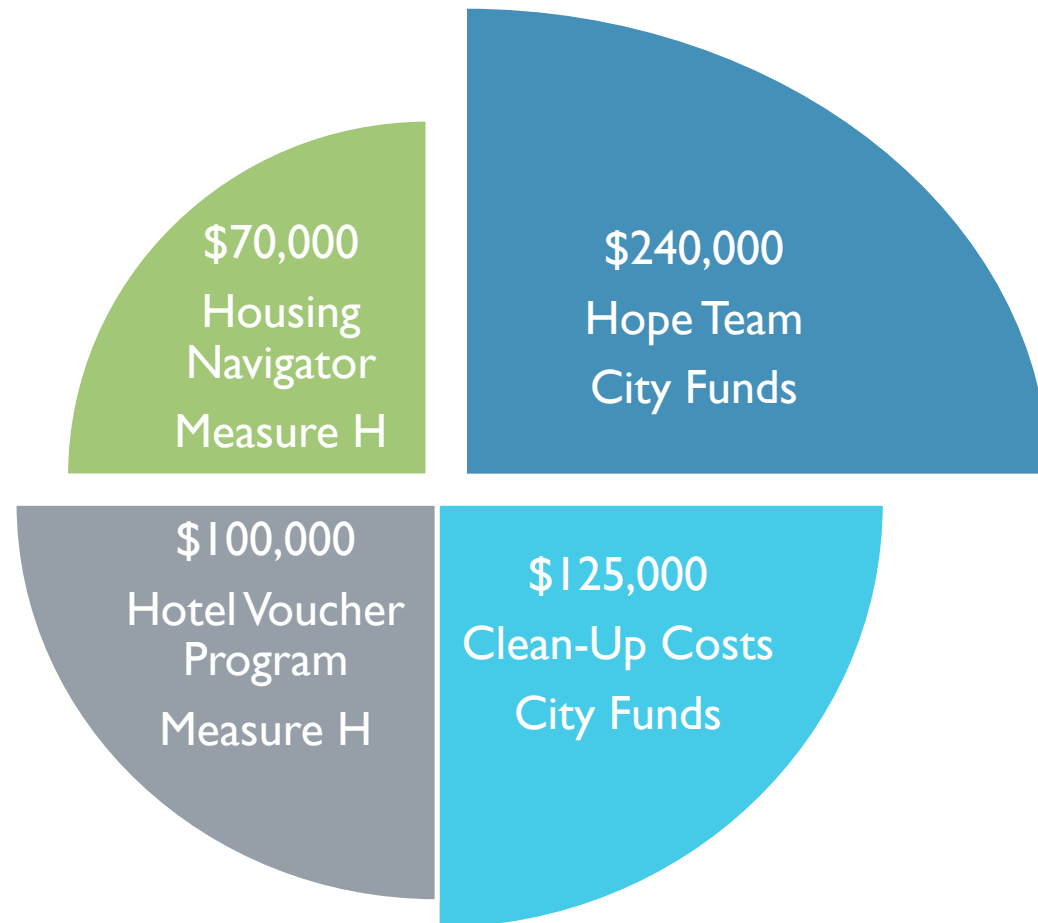
Emergency Hotel Voucher Program

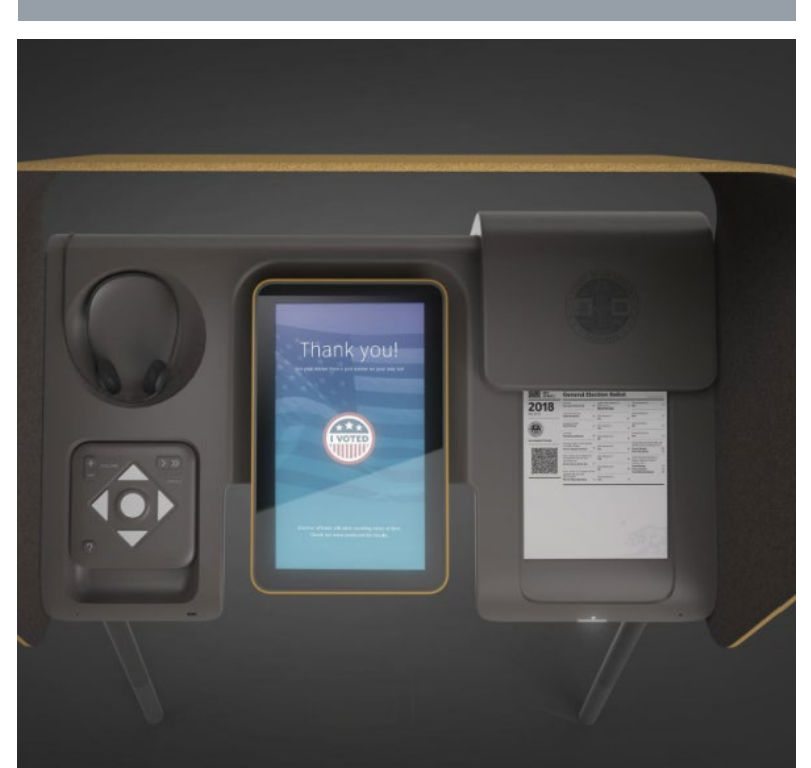

- Cortez Senior Center

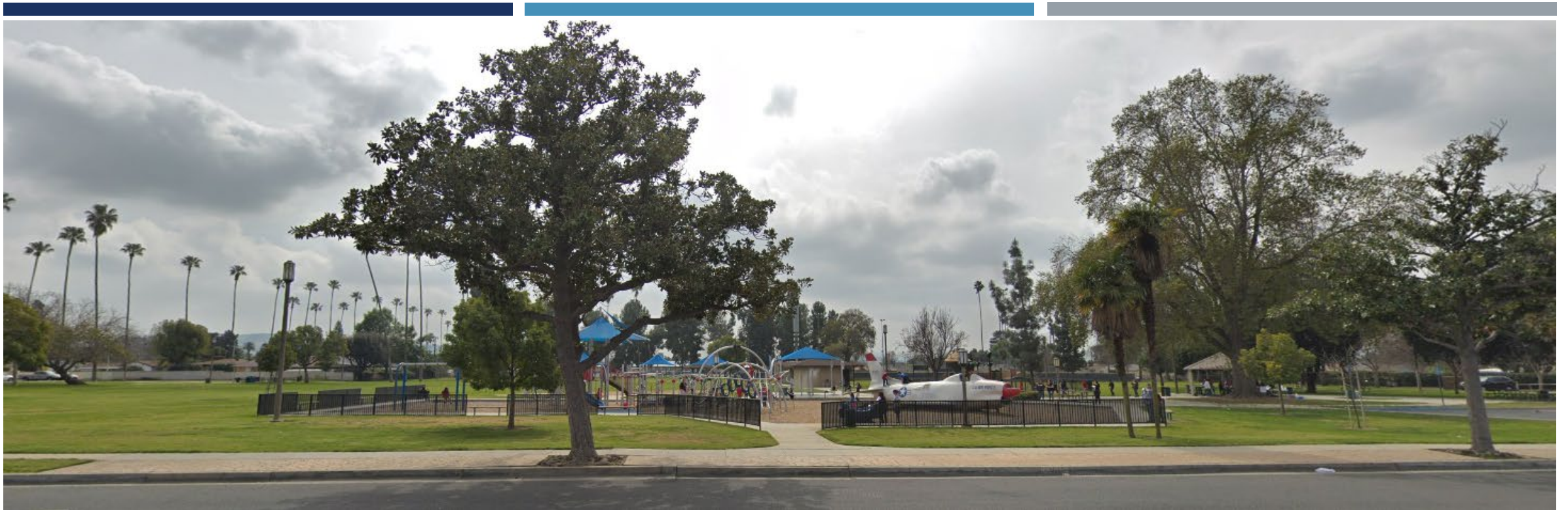


IN-PERSON VOTING (PROPOSED) LOCATIONS:
