On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20, suspending certain requirements of the Brown Act relating to the conduct of public meetings. Pursuant to the Executive Orders, Council Members may attend City Council meetings telephonically and the City Council is not required to make available a physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment.

On June 18, 2020, the California Department of Public Health issued guidance mandating that people in California wear cloth face coverings in specified circumstances, including when they are inside, or in line to enter, any indoor public space.

No comments will be read out loud during the meeting. All comments received will be made part of the official public record of the meeting.

TELEPHONIC ACCESSIBILITY: Members of the public that wish to address the Committee by telephone may do so by calling (714) 598-8896 by 12:00 noon on the day of the Committee meeting for instructions regarding addressing the Traffic Committee by telephone during the meeting.

- a) **Traffic Review of Garvey Avenue east of Baymar Avenue:** The City of West Covina received a request from a resident to review traffic conditions along Garvey Avenue east of Baymar Avenue between Azusa Avenue and Hollenbeck Avenue due to speeding concerns. After a thorough review of existing field and traffic conditions and per the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CAMUTCD) it was determined that the installation of additional speed limit signage would alert drivers of the speed on the roadway and reduce speeding vehicles traveling down Garvey Avenue in this area. It was unanimously recommended to install additional speed signage (35 mph) along the corridor with adjacent speed limit pavement legends ('35') midblock as well as on each end the corridor for both directions on Garvey Avenue between Azusa Avenue and Hollenbeck Avenue.
