On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20, suspending certain requirements of the Brown Act relating to the conduct of public meetings. Pursuant to the Executive Orders, Council Members may attend City Council meetings telephonically and the City Council is not required to make available a physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment.

On June 18, 2020, the California Department of Public Health issued guidance mandating that people in California wear cloth face coverings in specified circumstances, including when they are inside, or in line to enter, any indoor public space.

#### 2. Previous Traffic Committee Items Approved at the previous Traffic Committee Meeting

- a) **Traffic Review Along Montezuma Way between Vine Drive and Citrus Street:** The City has received a resident request to review reported speeding along Montezuma Way between Vine Drive and Citrus Street. The resident requested for speed bumps to be installed along Montezuma Way as well as the installation of streetlights. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended the installation of retroreflective strips on Stop sign poles along Montezuma Way between Vine Drive and Citrus Street, the installation of 25 mph pavement legends along Montezuma Way between Vine Drive and Citrus Street, the removal of existing 25 mph signage to be replaced by oversized (30"x36") 25 mph signage, and the removal of damaged sets of Raised Pavement Markers (RPM's) that are to be replaced by the installation of highly visible reflective RPM's for curved segments located along Montezuma Way between Vine Drive and Citrus Street. The Traffic Committee also agreed to review future grant funding opportunities when eligible or available such as street lighting and speed radar signage. This item will go before City Council for final approval.
- b) **Traffic Review Along Hillside Drive between Grand Avenue and Castle Rock Court:** The City has received a resident request to review reported speeding along Hillside Drive between Grand Avenue and Castle Rock Court. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended the installation of oversized (30"x36") 35 mph speed limit (R2-1) signs to replace the existing speed limits signs (24"x30") located along the northside and southside of Hillside Drive between Grand Avenue and Castle Rock Court, the installation of "35" mph pavement legends for eastbound and westbound travel opposite all oversized speed limit signs on Hillside Drive between Grand Avenue and Castle Rock Court, the installation of retroreflective strips on the Stop sign poles located along Hillside Drive from Grand Avenue to Castle Rock Court, the removal of damaged sets of Raised Pavement Markers (RPM's) that are to be replaced by the installation of new RPM's for curved segments located along Hillside Drive from Grand Avenue to Castle Rock Court, and the removal of existing advisory 35 mph speed plaque (W13-1) including the attached Left Curve (W1-2L) sign to be replaced with Advisory 25 mph speed plaque (W13-1). The Traffic Committee also agreed to review future grant funding opportunities when eligible or available such speed radar signage. This item will go before City Council for final approval.
