On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20, suspending certain requirements of the Brown Act relating to the conduct of public meetings. Pursuant to the Executive Orders, Council Members may attend City Council meetings telephonically and the City Council is not required to make available a physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment.

On June 18, 2020, the California Department of Public Health issued guidance mandating that people in California wear cloth face coverings in specified circumstances, including when they are inside, or in line to enter, any indoor public space.

No comments will be read out loud during the meeting. All comments received will be made part of the official public record of the meeting.

2. Previous Traffic Committee Items Approved at the previous Traffic Committee Meeting

- a) **Traffic Review Along Broadmoor Avenue and Rexwood Street:** The City received a resident request to review reported speeding at the curve where Broadmoor Avenue and Rexwood Street intersect. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended the installation of Horizontal Alignment Warning signs (W1-1) and 15 MPH Advisory Speed Plaques (W13-1P) at least 100 feet in advance of the beginning of the change in alignment, the installation of Chevron Alignment signs (W1-8) (18"x24") one sign for each direction of travel approaching the curve, the installation of Thermoplastic 50 feet of center line at the curve with yellow Raised Pavement Markers (RPMS) on Center line, the installation of 60 feet of red curb west of the curve, and the installation of 5 feet of red curb east of the curve. This item will go before City Council for final approval.

- b) **Traffic Review for the Intersection of Merced Avenue and Walnut Avenue:** The City received a request to review the traffic conditions at the intersection of Walnut Avenue and Merced Avenue to evaluate posting flashing stop signs. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended the removal of 6 existing Stop Signs at the intersection of Merced Avenue and Walnut Avenue to be replaced with 6 larger (R1-1) signs (36"x36") in all directions along with new "4-Way" (R1-3) (18"x6") plaques mounted underneath onto existing sign post, the installation of Red Reflective strips on all existing sign posts, the installation of yellow Thermoplastic Edge Lines around the medians for eastbound and westbound traffic as well as the installation of yellow Highly Reflective Raised Pavement Markers around the median, the removal of old existing Stop Ahead Signs (W3-1) to be replaced by Highly Reflective Neon Yellow Advance Stop Ahead Signs (W3-1) (30"x30") for eastbound, westbound, northbound, and southbound directions, the removal of existing crosswalk to be replaced by new Thermoplastic High Visibility ladder crosswalk with RPMS, the repainting of existing "STOP" pavement legends in White high visibility paint at intersection of Merced Avenue and Walnut Avenue, and the repainting of "STOP AHEAD" pavement legends for eastbound and westbound travel along Merced Avenue. This item will go before City Council for final approval.
