On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20, suspending certain requirements of the Brown Act relating to the conduct of public meetings. Pursuant to the Executive Orders, Council Members may attend City Council meetings telephonically and the City Council is not required to make available a physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment.

On June 18, 2020, the California Department of Public Health issued guidance mandating that people in California wear cloth face coverings in specified circumstances, including when they are inside, or in line to enter, any indoor public space.

No comments will be read out loud during the meeting. All comments received will be made part of the official public record of the meeting.

2. Previous Traffic Committee Items Approved at the previous Traffic Committee Meeting

- a) Red Curb Review at 2328 Merced Avenue: The City received a request for the removal of red curb located in front of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) located at 2328 Merced Avenue. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended removing approximately 100 feet of red curb from the southside of W. Merced Avenue, which would leave approximately 20 feet of red curb at either side of the curb adjacent to each of the VFW driveways and will provide approximately 100 feet of available curb space for vehicles to park. This item will go before City Council for final approval.
- b) Traffic Review at the Intersection of Hollenbeck Street at Rio Verde Drive: The City received a request to review the intersection of South Hollenbeck Street at East Rio Verde Drive. The Traffic Committee unanimously approved and recommended the installation of double sided 36x36" School Crossing S1-1 sign with 24x12" Downward Facing Arrow W16-7P at the uncontrolled marked school crosswalk for NB, SB approaches next to the crosswalk, installing School Crossing AHEAD Warning Sign (S1-1) (36x36") and Ahead Signage (W16-9P) (24x12") approaching the uncontrolled crosswalk NB and SB approaches, installing ladder crosswalks in yellow high visibility paint for the east, west, and south legs, installation of R1-5 "Yield Here to Pedestrian" signage with advanced shark teeth yield lines in white paint approaching the south and north leg at the uncontrolled crosswalk, as well as the installation of a retroreflective strip on the sign post to draw attention to the PEDESTRIAN WARNING signs during the nighttime conditions. This item will go before City Council for final approval.
- c) Discussion and Traffic Review along Azusa Avenue south of Garvey Avenue North: The City received a request to review the northbound right turn lane on Azusa Avenue at Garvey Avenue. This item was presented to the Traffic Committee for discussion and will be brought back to a later meeting with recommendations.
