City of West Covina Development Impact Fees Fee Descriptions and Rates For the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2024

Fee	Description		
Police Facilities	Fee revenue will help cover costs associated with police building improvements and the replacement of vehicles and capital equipment, communications, and computers.		
Fire Facilities	Fee revenue will be used to help fund a new Headquarter Fire Station and a renovated Fire Station 3 / Updated Medic Station and to replace capital equipment, such as the acquisition of new fire engines and other vehicles and equipment.		
Park Facilities	Fee revenue will contribute funding for parks and recreational facilities.		
Administrative Facilities	Fee revenue will be used to fund repairs and improvements to City Hall, Civic Center, and Council Chambers.		
Public Works Facilities	Fee revenue will be used towards the replacement of current Public Works vehicles, provide new vehicles, and improve the City Yard Above Ground Fuel Tanks.
